### CALL FOR ENTRIES

Regional artists may submit one original artwork to Tryon Arts & Crafts School's "Animals in Art" exhibition which will explore the wide-ranging and imaginative use of animals and wildlife as subjects in all media.

The *Animals in Art* show will be displayed in TACS' Side Gallery, concurrent with the main gallery exhibit, *Fictions of Fauna: Animals in Five Contemporary Artists' Works*, featuring Anne Berry, Todd Frahm, Lisa Hager, Bryant Holsenbeck, Barbara Schreiber. The *Animals in Art* show will be judged by Charlotte-based artist and arts organizer, Susan Jedrzejewski.

### ABOUT THE JUDGE

Susan Jedrzejewski has spent the last 16+ years supporting artists and the creative development of others including leadership roles at Goodyear Arts and McColl Center. She currently works at Hodges Taylor, providing art consulting services for public and private spaces and is co-founder of Riff Ideas. Susan received a BA in Studio Art from UNC Charlotte and an MBA from Queens University of Charlotte. As an artist, she has exhibited her work at Florida State University of Fine Art, Lodger Gallery, Rochester Contemporary Art Center, among others.

### Entry Material Requirements

1. Fill out and sign this agreement form
2. Attach TACS' label from page 3 of this document to your work.
3. Do not attach business cards or price tags to your work.

### Artwork Must Be Prepared for Display

- Wall art – secure hanging wires on the back
- 3-dimensional work – sand and/or adhere synthetic protective pads beneath
- Paper works (drawing, photography) – frame/mount with glass or plexiglass
- TACS has only a limited supply of display cases. If artists want to ensure that their work is encased, they should provide their own case(s).

### Location and Hours

**Space & Placement**

TACS determines the placement of items displayed in the show.

**Sales**

Sales will be subject to a 40% commission. TACS will collect and pay all sales tax.

**Liability Clause**

1. Unless otherwise noted, consigned objects from the artist will be covered on premises by the TACS' insurance policy, subject to policy terms and conditions. TACS will insure loaned objects on site. TACS may request an independent appraiser's evaluation.
2. If the artist waives TACS' insurance, this waiver constitutes a complete release of TACS from any liability arising from the loan. The artist must provide TACS with a certificate of insurance.
3. If the artist does not provide a valuation, s/he shall agree to accept an insurance value set by TACS. This value is not to be considered an appraisal.

**Opening Reception**

The opening reception is free and open to the public. Participating artisans are urged to attend and invite others.

**Artist Agreement**

*I have read the above information and I agree to all included terms. I agree to be responsible for the transportation of artwork to and from Tryon Arts & Crafts School on the above provided dates, respectively. In the event that I pick-up my artwork after the above provided date, I agree to pay a daily storage fee.*
